

NOTICE OF VACANCY

EDUCATIONAL AUDIOLOGIST

The Black Hawk Area Special Education District will be employing one, part-time Educational Audiologist with a starting date on or about August 2009. This position will provide comprehensive audiological services for children from birth to age twenty-one. These services will be for children residing in Rock Island County, Mercer County and parts of Henry County in Illinois. The selected candidate will clinically evaluate all categories of children and work with teachers and other educational personnel in the public schools. The Educational Audiologist will assist students with mild, temporary hearing loss as well as those who have severe/profound permanent loss. The audiologist will make recommendations about amplification and ensure the proper fit and functioning of the hearing aids/auditory devices.

LOCATION: Quad Cities Area in Northwestern Illinois along the Mississippi

SALARY/LENGTH OF CONTRACT: The length of contract will be 2-3 days/week, 10½ months. Salary will be determined by the years of experience and educational level of the selected candidate.

QUALIFICATIONS: The qualified candidate should have a certificate of Clinical Competence in Audiology (CCC-A) and/or a current Illinois Professional License in Audiology. Those with previous experience in an educational setting as well as strong Clinical Fellowship Year (CFY) candidates will be considered.
